

Welcome to Køge, Denmark and Capelli Sport Cup 2020

Welcome to the 2nd International Capelli Sport Cup – located in beautiful Køge with the oldest medieval town square in Denmark, beautiful Marina and cozy beaches. The new Capelli Sport Stadium is located in the City Center and just 30 minutes from Copenhagen and Copenhagen Airport.

Capelli Sport and HB Køge are excited to extend this invitation to teams in the following age groups: Under 17 (born in 2004 and 2005) and Under 19 (born in 2002 and 2003). Every team will be permitted to have two older players that are 1 year above their respective age group on the field at the same time. You can bring as many players and staff as you want but must follow substitution rules outlined on the rules page.

There are no tournament fees - teams will cover their own travel expenses, including airport transfers, local transport and hotels. Capelli Sport and HB Køge will provide 3 healthy buffet-style meals per day. Awards presented by Capelli Sport will be given to top teams and top individual performances.

There will be professional support staff on site, such as physios, to support all teams and players.

All matches will be recorded and presented to each team following each game.

We invite teams to arrive early to adjust to local time zones, climate and environment. Please plan to arrive in Køge July 20-23, with games being played July 23-26.

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 3 matches minimum for each team (2 x 45 minutes)
- If a game ends with a draw, a five-penalty shootout will take place. Winner will take two points from the game.
 Goals in penalty shootout don't count in total teams goals, or individual totals.
- Unlimited substitutions permitted; however, each team is only allowed to stop play on three occasions during the match.
 Substitutes are permitted at haftime and goalkeeper injury substitutions do not count as a stoppage.
- Tournament Director determines any suspensions or other
- Full referee teams for all matches
- Standings tiebreakers determined by:
 - 1. Goals difference
 - 2. Most goals scored
 - 3. Results in game between the two teams
 - 4. Draw

Køge Svømmeland (indoor pool) has room for lots of activities for children and adults of all ages.
